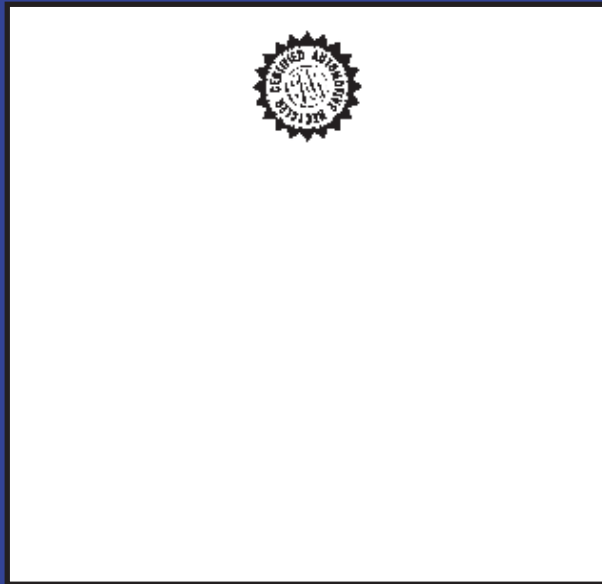

Environmental Standards

This business handles all hazardous wastes and materials in an environmentally responsible manner. To comply with CAR certification requirements we:

- Drain antifreeze, oil, transmission fluid, brake fluid, fuels and any other environmentally sensitive fluid from each vehicle during the dismantling process, for proper disposal, recycling or reuse as local state/provincial or national regulations proscribe.
- Remove all batteries and place them either in a covered storage area on a paved surface or in plastic containers with lids until they can be properly recycled.
- Evacuate refrigerant from each vehicle that is dismantled and also when any refrigerant holding part is removed from a vehicle. Refrigerant is recycled or properly disposed.
- Store all core engines and transmissions in leakproof lugger boxes, or in a covered area with a hard floor to prevent leaks from reaching the soil and ground water.
- Recycle all parts cleaner with an authorized processor.
- Store all tires properly for protection from fire and mosquito breeding.
- Comply with the current federal or state/provincial requirements and regulations dealing with storm water.
- A proud participant in the National Vehicle Mercury Switch Recovery Program.
- Partner with the US EPA in a National Program for Environmental Priorities, protecting the environment from non-compliant materials handling.



Safety Standards

As a CAR certified facility we:

- Require our personnel to utilize all basic personal safety equipment including gloves, hard hats, goggles, safety shoes, safety clothing, and safety shields as needed.
- Provide ABC fire extinguishers in all areas of the facility where they are required.
- Have a formal safety program which provides all employees with necessary safety information and procedures.
- Provide Manufacturers Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for all hazardous materials to our employees and have reviewed the applicable OSHA requirements pertaining to the Right to Know Program and Employee Safety.
- Require the proper training for forklift operation by all employees who operate forklifts.
- Require training and certification for the proper handling and transport of Air Bags.
- Safeguard and train our employees on the proper use of cutting torches, in accordance with the ARA Torch Protocol.
